

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

To apply for a Foreign Operators Permit the following documents have to be submitted:

A fully completed TV 2/297 application form – initialized on all pages. (Attached)

A fully completed SACAA form. (Attached)

Aircraft documents certified by a commissioner of oaths.

- Operator's Certificate and the Air Operators Specifications

- Airworthiness Certificate

- Certificate of Registration

- Certificate of Insurance

- Maintenance Release Certificate

- Installation certificate on the TCAS II Version 7.

- Installation certificate on the GPWS.

- Radio Station Licence

- Noise Certificate

- RVSM approval (Reduced Vertical Separation Minimum Airspace)

- Lease Agreement documents (if necessary)

- Letter of Authority (if necessary)

Aviation Security Programme. (Scheduled FOP only) [two(02) Hard copies and one soft copy on a disk]

Formal letter of designation from the state. (Scheduled FOP only)

Supporting letters from the Consignee/Consignor **and** a proper cargo description/cargo manifest (Non-Scheduled FOP only).

All documentation has to be sending by post or courier services, No faxes or e-mails will be expectable.

The Department of Transport, South Africa need between 10 to 20 working days for processing, **after** submitting all the correct documentation.
